Pennsylvania Wine Land is home to over 350 wineries across all sixty seven counties of the state. The great diversity of wineries throughout the state means that there is more than one winery that will pair with your taste or mood. PA wineries can be small, large, modern, rustic, family-run, or multi-generational.

The options of Pennsylvania wine are endless. Each new vintage allows Winemakers in PA to take on traditional winemaking processes and experiment with new methods. Over 50 varieties of grapes grow in PA, including traditional European, Hybrid, and Native varieties.

This guide will introduce you to the wines and wineries across Pennsylvania, but as always, the best way to get to know them is to **keep tasting**.

1683

PA Wine Land, as we know it, is only about 50 years old, but its roots were planted more than three hundred years ago when William Penn cultivated the state's first vineyard in what is now Philadelphia's Fairmount Park.



1807

The Harmonists, a German religious sect, bring commercial winemaking to the SouthWest region of Pennsylvania. Their 30,000 gallon arched stone cellar is still there today in Ambridge, PA.

1787

The country's first commercial vineyard was founded. Shareholders include Alexander Hamilton, Aaron Burr, John Hopkins, Robert Morris, and Citizen Genet.



1900

Winemaking is happening in all of PA's 67 counties.

1920 - 1933

Prohibition

1933

The Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board (PLCB) is founded. Commercial wine production resumes, but only state-operated stores can sell it.



1968

The Limited Winery Act goes into effect permitting wineries to make up to 50,000 gallons of wine using Pennsylvania grown fruit, and to sell their wine directly to the public, hotels, restaurant, clubs, and the PLCB.



1969

Presque Isle Wine Cellars and Penn Shore Vineyard became the first two licensed wineries in Pennsylvania.



2024

The PA wine industry has grown to over 350 licensed wineries, producing more than two million gallons of wine each year (that's more than 10 million bottles!).

SPRING

In the Spring, vineyard managers and winemakers keep their eyes peeled for buds to emerge from the vines. This is called “bud break”.

The excitement of new beginnings spread through the vineyards to the tasting rooms. The warm weather invites guests to tasting rooms and patios to enjoy chilled bottles of white and rosé wines.



SUMMER

Sunny summer days and cool summer nights are the ideal conditions for leaf and canopy growth to support grape ripening. “Veraison” is a special time in late summer when the grapes begin to change color, ripen, and accumulate sugars.



Wineries make the most of every summer minute with a bustling calendar of warm-weather events. Wine tastings accompany a relaxing environment of ambient music and vineyard views.



AUTUMN

"Harvest Season" is the busiest time in Pennsylvania vineyards. Vineyard managers wait for exactly the right time to pick the grapes they've been tending to throughout the growing season.

The only place that can rival the pace of the vineyard during this season is the tasting room. Harvest events and festivals attract visitors by the hundreds. As the weather turns crisp and cool, the leaves turn brilliant making the trip through Pennsylvania a stunning part of the experience.



OCTOBER IS *PA Wine Month*

Thirty-one wonderful days of special things to do, taste, and discover all across the state.

Wineries, restaurants, and wine trails host events, offer specials, and celebrate the local wine industry.

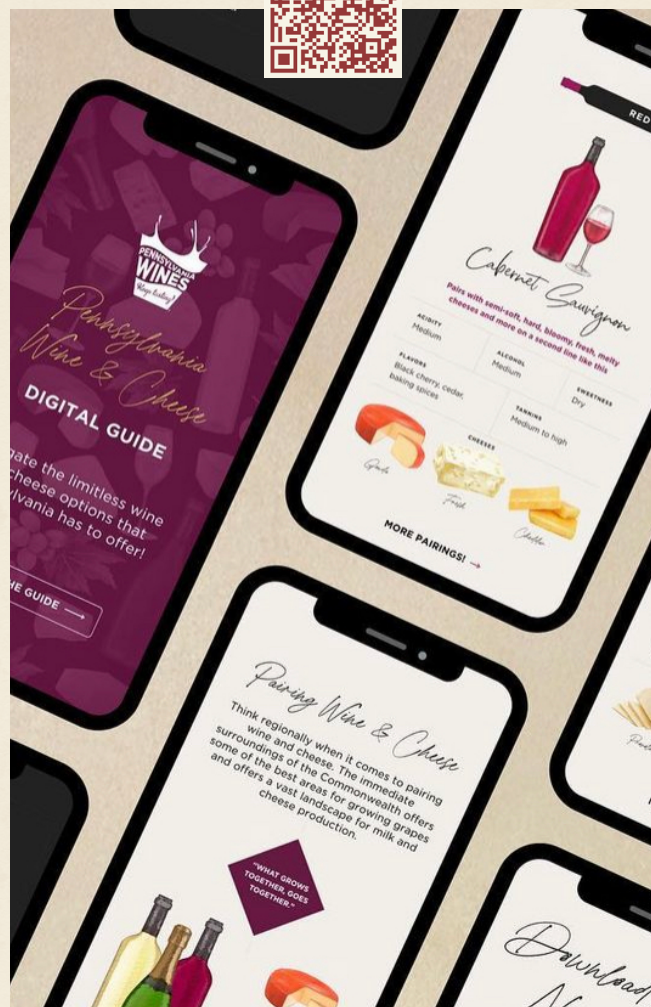

GET TO KNOW Pennsylvania Wine Grapes

PENNSYLVANIA'S CLIMATE AND TERROIR NURTURE
A DIVERSE VARIETY OF GRAPES TO DELIGHT ANY PALATE.

FROM LIGHTEST WHITE TO DEEPEST RED

***Note:** Wine color varies greatly from region to region, winery to winery, and winemaker to winemaker. The scale below is based on the average expression of each wine.*



RIESLING (*REES-ling*) varies from sweet to dry depending on wineaking style and region of origin. Wines from the NorthWest region have a sweet peach flavor with a crisp tartness, while SouthCentral Rieslings have more citrus and floral notes. (E)



CAYUGA (*kuh-YOO-guh*) is a workhorse: it is cold-hardy, high yielding, disease resistant, reliably high quality, and can be made into dry, sweet, or sparkling styles depending on when it's harvested. (H)



VIGNOLES (*veen-YOL*) is an aromatic variety with tropical fruit characters. Its sweet, fruity flavors can be made into a dessert/ice wine or a lightly sweetened table wine. It can also be aged in oak to produce a more rounded wine. (H)



DELAWARE (*DEH-luh-wair*) is typically on the sweeter side and can be made in white, rosé, dessert, and sparkling styles. It is grown across the state, but primarily in the NorthWest region. (N)



VIDAL BLANC (*vee-DAHL BLAHNk*) boasts tropical fruit notes and can be produced in dry, semi-dry, dessert, and ice wine styles. It is grown across the state and varies by region. Wines produced in the NorthWest region are bright and crisp while those from the SouthCentral region are more floral in flavor. (H)



ALBARIÑO (*Ahl-bah-REE-nyoh*) is a dry, crisp alternative to Sauvignon Blanc. When grown in warmer regions with more clay in the soil, ripe fruit flavors take center stage while grapes from cooler climates and sandier soil showcase strong citrus notes. (E)



SEYVAL BLANC (*say-VAHL BLAHNk*) is a dry white that can be either aged in oak, made into sparkling wine, or employed in a blend. In addition to its versatility, its resistance to cold weather makes it popular throughout Pennsylvania. It exhibits minerality and notes of citrus, green apple, hay, and melon. (H)



SAUVIGNON BLANC (*sow-vuhn-YAHN BLAHNk*) is one of the most widely planted wine grapes in the world and because of this it has a wide range of styles and flavors. The primary flavors are lime, green apple, passion fruit and white peach. Depending on grape ripeness, the dry white can range in flavor from zesty lime to flowery peach. What makes Sauvignon Blanc unique is its herbaceous flavors like bell pepper and its medium to high acidity. (E)



GRÜNER VELTLINER (*GREW-ner velt-LEE-ner*) is a crisp, aromatic white with a grassy, herbal flavor and hints of tropical fruits. Wines tend to be dry and full bodies, with high acidity and distinct notes of spice and white pepper. It is well-established in the SouthEast and NorthWest regions, with the first vines in PA planted in 2003. (E)



CHARDONNAY (*SHAR-duh-nay*) can be made in a variety of styles including sparkling, unoaked, and oaked. Fruity, floral flavors with high acidity are apparent in sparkling and unoaked styles, while barrel-aged Chardonnays have hints of vanilla and caramel. Local Chardonnays are very similar to a European-style. (E)



PINOT GRIGIO or PINOT GRIS (*PEE-noh GREE-joe or PEE-noh-GREE*) is named for its pinkish-grey skin and typically made in a dry, zesty, unoaked style. Pinot Gris can have flavors of citrus, pear, apple and peach fruit flavors. (E)



MUSCAT (*moss-KAAT*) is a light-bodied, sweet white wine with tropical fruit notes and floral aromas that can be produced in a still or slightly sparkling style. (E)



GEWÜRZTRAMINER (*guy-VERTZ-tra-mean-er*) is an off-dry wine with bold aromatics of lychee and rose petals. Fresh flavors like lime and lemongrass are sometimes punctuated by a bit of fizz. (E)



TRAMINETTE (*TRA-men-et*) can be made in off-dry and dry styles, with spicy and floral aromas alongside flavors of lychee, apricot, and honey. It can be found across Pennsylvania, primarily in the NorthCentral and SouthEast regions. (H)



NIAGARA (*nay-AE-gruh*) is a sweet wine with grape flavors and candied lemon and floral jasmine aromas. Niagara grapes are grown across PA, primarily in the NorthWest region. (N)



CATAWBA (*kuh-TAW-buh*) resembles a White Zinfandel with sweetness, medium body, and moderate acidity. It has floral aromas and red berry flavors. Grown and produced across the state, but mostly in the NorthWest region. (N)



BACO NOIR (*BAH-koh NWAHR*) is lush and dry and can be made in a variety of styles. Lighter expressions have aromas of raspberry and blueberry and flavors of sour cherry, earth and oak. Darker expressions are more robust with flavors of blackberry and tobacco. (N)



STEUBEN (*STOO-ben*) is a cold-hardy hybrid variety that is often produced into a sweeter style of wine. Rosé wines exhibit strawberry and raspberry notes with hints of tea leaves and cinnamon. Red wines are made in a drier style with cranberry notes and a certain tartness. (H)



PINOT NOIR (*PEE-noe NWAHR*) is dry with a stunning garnet color, medium body, vivid acidity, and smooth tannins. Look for flavors of cherry, rose petals, and mushrooms. Oak aging contributes to clove, tobacco, leather, and vanilla. (E)



MARQUETTE (*mar-KET*) is a complex hybrid related to Pinot Noir. It produces a similar style wine with medium body, red berry flavors, and a peppery spice. It can also be produced in a rosé style. (H)



MARECHAL FOCH (*MAH-reh-shal FOSH*) can vary from dry to sweet. It is often used in a Port-style wine. A strong acidity is balanced by aromas of black fruits with flavors of toasted wheat, fresh coffee, chocolate, vanilla bean. (H)

**PETIT VERDOT** (*pet-TEE our-DOE*)

can vary from dry to sweet. It is often used in a Port-style wine. A strong acidity is balanced by aromas of black fruits with flavors of toasted wheat, fresh coffee, chocolate, and vanilla bean. (E)

**TEROLDEGO** (*tehr-AWL-deh-go*)

is fresh, bright, and dry with mild tannins, punchy acidity, and aromas of dark fruit and smoke. Flavors include cranberry, pomegranate, and raspberry balanced out by pepper, anise, and earth. (E)

**CABERNET FRANC** (*CAB-er-nay FRANC*)

is a red variety known for its complex flavors and aromatic profile, often featuring notes of raspberry, bell pepper, and violet. Originating from the Bordeaux region of France, it has gained popularity as both a standalone varietal and as a blending grape in Bordeaux-style blends. Cabernet Franc thrives in wine regions worldwide, including Pennsylvania. (E)



CONCORD (*KON'-chord*) is a sweet, dark red with a strong grape-y flavor. It can be grown across PA, but is primarily found in the NorthWest region where it is mostly used for juice or jelly. (N)



CHANCELLOR (*CHAN-suh-ler*) is typically ruby red in color with medium body and mild acidity. Its fruit flavors of soft red cherries, blackberries, and cinnamon. It can also be dry and barrel-aged. (H)



MERLOT (*mer-LOW*) has fruity flavors of plum and red raspberry, and typically has earthy flavors with hints of mushroom. Grown in the SouthCentral and SouthEast regions of the state, the wine's flavor is impacted by the climate. (E)

**LEMBERGER** (*LEHM-ber-ger*)

or Blaufränkisch (Blah-FRAHN-keesh) is a red grape variety native to Central Europe, and produces robust red wines known for their deep color and spicy character. With flavors ranging from dark berries to peppery undertones, Blaufränkisch wines often exhibit a delightful balance of fruitiness and acidity. (E)

**CHAMBOURCIN** (*SHAHM-boor-sin*)

has earthy, tobacco, and vanilla aromas, a supple mouthfeel, and an intense red color. It is often aged in oak to round out the body. Chambourcin can be found all across Pennsylvania. (H)



CABERNET SAUVIGNON (*CAB-er-nay SAW-vin-YAWN*) is greatly impacted by its growing climate, requiring a long, warm season to ripen. Cool, wet vintages bring herbal and earthy notes, while warm, dry vintages are fruity. Cabernet Sauvignon has high tannins and high acidity and is usually aged in oak barrels. (E)



CARMINE (*CAR-meen; CAR-mine*) produces a full-bodied, deep crimson wine with strong, dry tannins and high acidity. It has dark fruit flavors, herbaceous aromas, and peppery notes, and is suited to oak aging. (H)



SYRAH (*sih-RAH*) is another grape that is greatly impacted by its climate. Warmer growing seasons produce jammy, red fruit flavors while cooler growing seasons bring out chocolate, coffee, and earthy notes. It can be found in vineyards across the globe from France to Australia (called Shiraz) to Pennsylvania. (E)



NOIRET (*nwahr-ET*) is dry and peppery with hints of raspberry, blackberry and mint. Wines can be quite herbaceous and fruit-driven with soft tannins. When used in a Port-style wine, notes of raspberry, dried blackberry, cocoa powder, espresso, and black cherry are apparent. (H)



SAPERAVI (*sah-per-RA-vee*) is typically a full-bodied dry red with an inky color, but can also be made in rosé, semi-sweet, sweet, and fortified styles. Flavors of dark fruits, cherry, blackberry, spices, smoke, and licorice are joined by cedar and vanilla when aged in oak. (E)

(E) **European Grapes**

(or *Vitis Vinifera*) grow well in Pennsylvania because the high continentality - hot summers and cold winters - resembles a European climate.

(H) **Hybrid Grapes**

are created by crossing two or more grape species. They are designed for hardiness, tolerating pests, and adverse climate conditions while maintaining quality.

(N) **Native Grapes**

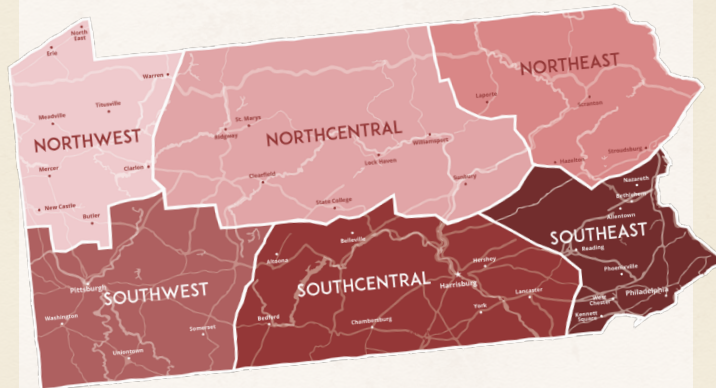
are found naturally in Pennsylvania and have adapted to the climate and soil. They can be found across the state (including your backyard).

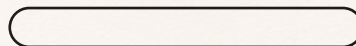

NORTHWEST

A 20-mile long and 5-mile wide landscape of grapevines hug the Lake Erie shoreline.

The Lake has a moderating effect (Lake Effect) making the surrounding climate cooler in the spring and warmer in the fall than areas even a few miles inland. It also provides adequate air movement which means that weather conditions remain relatively consistent from year-to-year compared to some other regions.

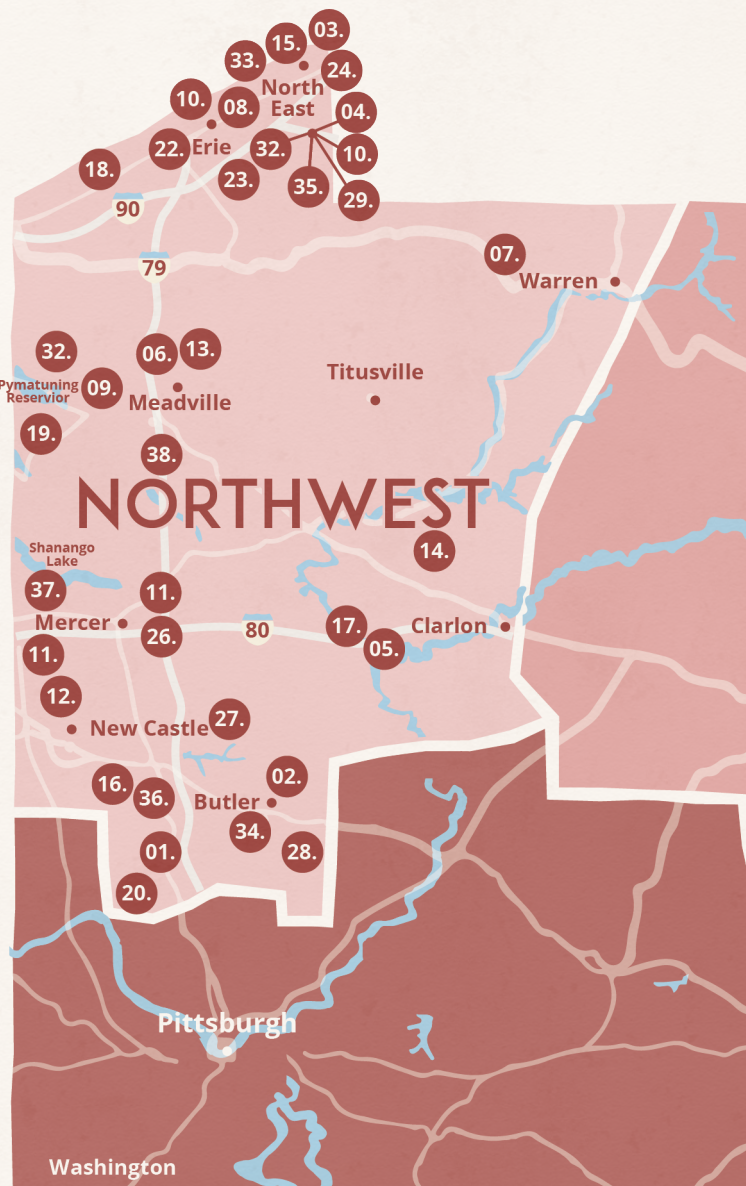

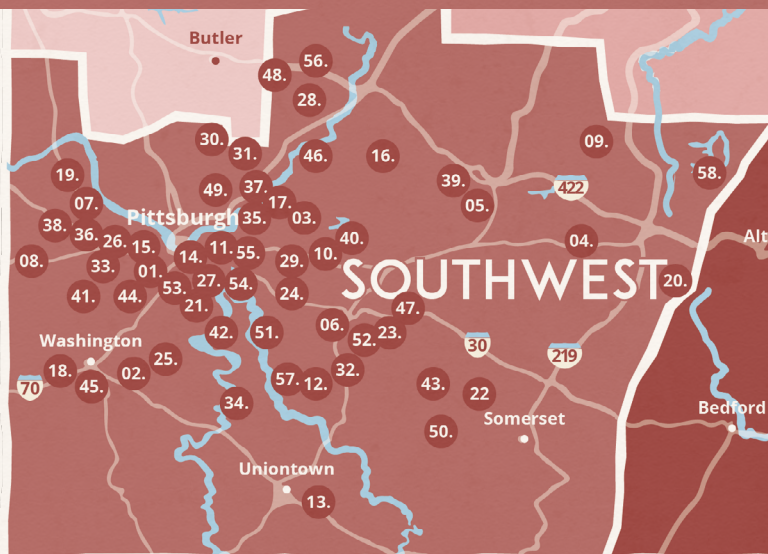


SOUTHWEST

SOUTHEAST

The SouthEast typically experiences a longer growing season and higher temperatures and humidity than other regions. This allows for a wide variety of warm- and cool- climate vinifera grapes as well as several hybrid grapes to thrive. The generally hilly terrain of the region presents opportunities for establishing vineyard sites with south-facing slopes that aid in draining water and maintaining air flow which encourages grapevines to flourish.

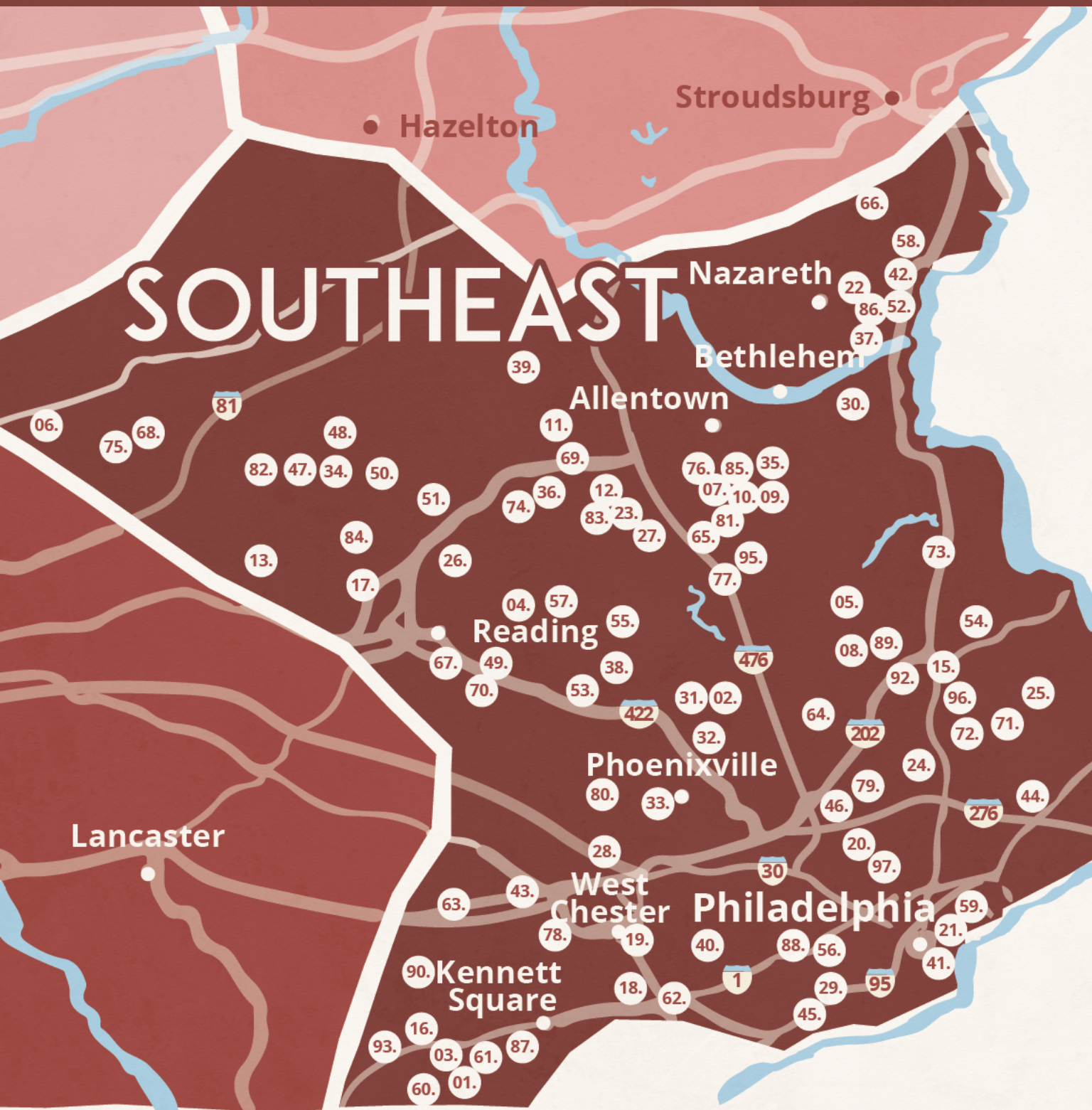

Tasting TERMS

Helpful words to know and use in the tasting room

ACIDITY This is a quality in wine that provides tartness and pucker. Wines with high acidity will taste bright and fresh. White wines tend to be more acidic than red wines.

AROMA Smell is an essential part of tasting and enjoying wine. The aroma varies depending on the grape variety, fermentation, and aging methods. Typical aromas include citrus, flowers, tropical fruit, berries, herbs, and spices.

BODY Wines are typically categorized as light-bodied, medium-bodied, or full-bodied. Body describes the texture or weight of the wine on the palate. Fuller-bodied wines are generally higher in alcohol content.

ESTATE WINE Wines labeled as "estate" must be made using grapes from vineyards owned by the winery - it does not leave the property during fermentation, aging, or bottling.

FINISH This refers to the flavors that linger on the palate after the wine has been swallowed. It is an important factor in separating middling wines from high quality ones. Fine wines will have a long-lasting, pleasant finish that leaves you wanting more.

TANNIN Tannin is a naturally occurring polyphenol found in the grape's skins, seeds, and stems. Tannins create a drying sensation on the tongue - think of unsweetened black tea. Tannins are mainly found in red wines, adding texture and complexity.

VARIETALS This word describes wines made from primarily a single type of grape. For example, Merlot wine is named after the grape variety. A Tasting Room Manager or Sommelier might ask you which varietals you have enjoyed in the past. Varietal is the wine; Variety is the grape.

VINTAGE A wine's vintage indicates what year the grapes were grown. If you do not see a vintage on the bottle, it might mean that grapes from different growing years have been blended to produce that wine.
