

The Central Delaware Valley Pennsylvania Viticulture Area (PVA), also recognized as an American Viticulture area (AVA) draws its character from the Delaware River. The river is recognized as one of the nation's "Great Waters" by the America's Great Waters Coalition and a vital moderating force in the landscape. Rocky, iron-rich soils and fractured shale naturally limit vigor, helping produce concentrated, finely structured fruit, while well-drained slopes give growers confidence season after season.

Consistent breezes and the river's steady influence create a mild micro-climate ideal for wines of bright acidity. Dry whites, rosés, and sparkling wines shine here, with Riesling often leading the way as growers continue to explore new expressions of this region.

A holistic vision of regenerative farming, welcoming hospitality, and thoughtfully designed guest experiences deepen the connection between product, place, and purpose. As perceptions of Pennsylvania wine continue to evolve, the Central Delaware Valley PVA stands ready to show how refined, site-driven wines and meaningful celebrations can flow naturally from a landscape shaped by one of America's Great Waters.
