

2018 Pennsylvania Farm Show

Application Submission Updates and Requirement

Please note: The PWA will NOT accept any registration documents prior to the date and time the registration email is sent to all members.

This is **NOT** a registration email.

Highlights for the 2018 Farm Show Registration and Participation:

- In order to participate in the 2018 Farm Show the PWA 2018 Membership Dues payment (checks only) and completed dues form must be enclosed with the required materials and fees for the Farm Show registration application
- The PWA will not accept faxes, emails, partial documents or hand delivery of ANY application as entry for the Farm Show
- In order to be considered a participant we will need ALL paperwork and fees MAILED to the PWA by the deadline specified
- Please note this event is first-come first-serve
- All participating wineries being registered as PA Preferred with the Department of Agriculture, the wines showcased (tasting/selling) at the Farm Show must be eligible to be considered PA Preferred
 - To meet this standard, the wines must be labeled as Pennsylvania Wines, meaning at least 75% of the grapes used to make the wine were grown in Pennsylvania

Following are the items that **MUST** be received for you winery to be considered a fully registered participant:

- Your winery must renew your Limited Winery License with the PLCB by **December 15th, 2017**
- 2018 PWA Membership Form
- 2018 PWA Membership Dues (Payable to the PWA)
- 2018 Farm Show Registration Form
- Festival Policy Statement
- Festival Participation Guidelines
- Registration and Special Permit Fee: \$660 (Payable to the PWA)
 - The PWA will file the Special Permit with the PLCB vic PLCB+ -- your winery will not need to file the permit, this will be entered by the PWA
 - By registering, your winery is authorizing the PWA to enter the permit on behalf of your winery
- Check for parking passes: \$30 for 2 commercial exhibitors one day parking passes (Check made payable to the PWA)
